

## **Year 4 Read, Write, Inc. Spelling**

### **Week 1 & 2**

Adding the prefix mis-, and revising un-, in-, dis-. Children to understand that adding a prefix to a root word changes a word to its opposite meaning e.g. misbehave.

### **Week 3 & 4**

Words ending in zhuh spelt -sure. Children to understand that endings which sound like zhuh are always spelt -sure e.g. treasure and measure.

### **Week 5 & 6**

Adding the prefix auto-. Children to understand that adding the prefix auto- means 'self' or 'own' e.g. autograph.

### **Week 7 & 8**

Adding the suffix -ly. Children to understand that by adding the suffix -ly to an adjective you create an adverb e.g. the adjective final becomes the adverb finally. We sometimes swap the y for an i before adding the suffix -ly. E.g. happy becomes happily.
