Adding the suffix -ly

We can add the suffix -ly to an adjective to make it an adverb. adjective: final adverb: finally. We sometimes swap the y for an i before adding the suffix -ly. happy becomes happily

Week 9 & 10

Adding the prefix inter-

The prefix inter- means 'among' or 'between'. national becomes international.

Week 11 & 12

Words with the ay sound.

The ay sound can be spelt eigh, ei or ey e.g. eight, rein and grey.

Week 13 & 14

Words ending in -ous

The suffix -ous can just be added to some root words (e.g. mountainous.) If a root word ends in -our, we have to swap the letters our for or before adding the suffix -ous. humour becomes humorous.
